Minutes

Directors Present: Director Fielding, President Miller, and Director Millslagle a quorum is established.

1. **Call to Order**

The meeting of the Meeks Bay Fire Protection District Board of Directors for the month of September was called to order at 3:31 p.m. by President Miller.

2. **Additions to Agenda/Approval of Agenda**

There were no additions or changes to the agenda. There was no public comment.
